Information on Admission to K1 Classes in the 2027/2028 School Year

Application Form (No quota):-

9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (Saturdays)

Application Method:-

Submit the application form in person

☆ Submit below documents together with the form.

1. Original and copy of the child's Birth Certificate.
 - * In case of Children not born in Hong Kong will also need to provide the original and copy of the child's passport page which includes the child's photo, ID and Hong Kong Visa approval stamps (showing authorized residency status).
2. Original and copy of the child's Vaccination Record.
3. Two recent photos, sized 1.5" x 2".
4. Original and copy of the baptism certificate (for Catholic child only).

Submit the application form by post or email

By post:

Please submit the application form together with photos, payment receipt of the application fee and the copy of the above documents.

On email:

Please submit the application form and the documents in PDF file, photos in JPG file, and the payment receipt of the application fee in JPG / PDF file.

***After receiving the application form, parents will receive an email confirmation and interview notification within one week. If the parent does not receive the confirmation email, please call our school for enquiry.**

(The application fee is non-refundable under all circumstances.)

Interview Arrangements:-

1. After submitting the application form, the interviewing time will be given to parents through email by our kindergarten. We will arrange interviews for all applicants.
2. Parents should accompany their child for the interview according to the interview time given by email. Interviews will be conducted on 31st October, 2026 (Saturday).
3. Individual or group interviews will be arranged. Teachers will observe child's performance during interview.

*** We will arrange interpretation and translation for the Non-Chinese children.**

Announcement of Admission Results:-

We will inform parents of the K1 admission's results before 13th November, 2026 (Friday) by email.



Registration Arrangements:-

1. Successful applicants: Parents should complete the registration procedures for their child from 7th to 9th January, 2027 ("Centralised Registration Dates") by submitting the electronic "Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission" (hereafter referred to as "e-RC") to the kindergarten and paying the registration fee. (HK\$970 for Half Day session and \$1,570 for Whole Day session.)

*** If parents decide to change school after registration, please notify the kindergarten in writing and bring the e-RC to school to arrange the cancellation of registration. However, the registration fee will not be refunded.**

*** If the child confirmed studies in the kindergarten, the paid will be refunded in September 2026.**

2. Applicants on the waiting list: If there are vacancies after the Centralised Registration Dates, our kindergarten will notify parents of the registration arrangements by email. Parents should complete the registration procedures for their child according to the specified date set by the school. Parents are required to submit the e-RC for registration and pay the registration fee.

3. Please be reminded that if parents cannot submit the e-RC during registration, the kindergarten may not be able to complete registration for their child. Hence, parents are required to submit application for the Registration Certificate to EDB within the specified period.

Priority / Admission Criteria:-

1. Applicants with sibling(s) currently studying in the kindergarten.
2. Interview performance.
3. Applicants living near the school.
4. Applicants with a past family connection to the kindergarten (a supporting document is required).
5. Catholic children (Required to submit the baptism certificate).
6. Applying for WD session: Those with working parents or those taking care of one or more persons with a disability at home (a supporting document is required).



*** As the numbers of school places are limited, please understand that not all applicants fulfilling the priority consideration will be guaranteed a school place.**

Application for the “2027/28 Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission”

Parents are required to submit an application for the “2027/28 Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” to the EDB **from September to November 2026**. The “2027/28 RC” will be open for applications in September 2026 and the EDB will announce and upload the details of application onto the EDB’s website in due course.
